Do authorities work?

According to our information, all authorities keep working. Jobcenter and Labour Agencies offer no personal appointments anymore. They only offer eService.

Access to Education

Saxon schools and kindergardens are closed. The social ministry didn't say for how long.

Kids can be taken care of in emergencies. But only if their parents have an important profession. The social ministry has defined a couple of important professions, for example doctors, police officers or waste disposal.

Who to turn to if I've got symptoms?

IMPORTANT: In case symptoms of Corona appear, DON'T go to the doctor. Better call one of the hotlines. You'll be connected with the local health agency. It is important to call the correct health agency. The correct health agency is determined by the place of your living. This means, it depends on the county (Landkreis) or the city (Dresden, Leipzig, Chemnitz).

You might call the doctor as well. They can give you information as well.

won't be quarantined and people will be distributed among the counties and cities. It should be possible to accommodate people in hostels and hotels – no matter if they're sick or healthy.

There are further, huge camps in Saxony. Those are the „Gemeinschaftsunterkünfte.“ They belong to the counties and cities. One example is the camp on Torgauer Straße in Leipzig. SFR hopes as well, that people will be transferred to apartments, hostels, hotels as quickly as possible. SFR told Ministry of the Interior that. We hope for quick and multilingual information.
